EVANGELICAL WORK: This summer is the great time for children as the vocational bible classes begins & this is the time children have great fun in learning bible stories, lots of games, new songs & lots of gifts .the evangelists in our mission had began the grounding work among the children through the VBS. On 30th April I was invited for the validation function of VBS at Kannam mitta by pastor .Sunder raj, where 70 children from that village attended for the VBS. They were presented with gifts & certificates. Pastor. Wesley reported that he also held VBS from 27th to 4th may.27 children attended

the classes. Pastor. Yesupadam reported that he also conducted VBS in his place. Others are planning to have VBS during this month.



We were invited by CHRIST MINISTRIES, at a place called, Tenali on 24th & 25th which is about 400 km away from Puttur. We started at 8am in the morning and reached in the evening. It is 3days revival meeting & we were called for the last 2 days. I spoke word of God, which was blessing to me and to many.



The GSM team lead by Bro. Praveen Kumar(My son) were invited to minister in an island, Irakam, with the population of 200 & it is 30 km away from the Kolladam. They started at 6 am & reached the destination at 11.am by a boat. It is an unreached place for gospel, as it is hard task to reach there & it is an hour journey & has no proper traveling facilities. We were the first people to do gospel work there. They started prayer at 11am & finished it by 1.am. while on our way back they had tough time on travelling as the tides are strong in the afternoon & the boat became unsteady, as if it is going to sink. They told the driver to drive back to the village. They were at that place till 4pm in the evening till the water became still. It was a great experience for our people. Praise GOD for protecting them from the tough situation.

We are continuing with regular fasting prayer on Friday & Sunday worship at our chapel and evangelical work at other villages .Myself and Praveen are visiting our sister concern churches at different villages.

Construction work of David memorial church at Yanadimettu has been started .the under construction church at Govindapalem sponsored by VBS children, St.Joseph is under process of completion. We want to dedicate both churches when the summer team from St.Joseph, Missouri, USA visits our mission.

ORPHANAGE: the children are on summer vacation, which is from 24th of April and going to be up to June 12th .Some children have gone to visit their parents & some are spending their vacation at orphanage. The hostels wardens are also on summer vacation .they are working on turns .the schools are reopening on 12th June. New Students are going to join & few students are ready to leave the institution.



Four students from our orphanage successfully completed nursing, remaining 6 students have 6 months to complete. All the pre university students (12 the class) has been passed out with cent percent results!!! Praise GOD for that. We are waiting for the 10 the grade

student's results, pray for them. After June 12th the students will be going to the higher classes & some join the colleges as the academic year for student's starts from the month of June



HOSPITAL WORK : The work at GSM hospital, Puttur going well by HIS grace .All the staff & doctors are working diligently .We have got new gynecologist Dr.Manikarnika ,in the place of our previous doctor. She is going to stay in the mission guest house.



HIV/AIDS PROJECT: By HIS grace we got the remaining portion of land & we made an agreement with the sellers. The ground breaking ceremony has been conducted on April 30th. Rt. Rev.Mano Daniel and Dr. Shela are invited as the chief guests for this occasion & my belief is that if we start the project with prayer, GOD will help us till the completion of the project, so I decided to do the ceremony. The physical therapy department is going to be equipped in July.



We are regular with our medical camps in different villages. Our state minister for law technical & higher education was invited for one of the medical camp at Nagiri. GSM is reaching influential people with gospel & praying for the ministers in government service. The team 2008 from PA is praying for him.



KOLLADAM: Project, Austin Memorial Rural Medical Centre running well. As there is no medical facility around 12 km radius, many villagers visit here from surround places. We are offering them medical care at free of cost. They even don't have proper transport facility & uses bullock carts / few patients are carried on Cots by the people.
